Located in a rehabbed warehouse, the 17 residential and 3 commercial units house artists and their families in an environment supportive of creative



work and collaboration. The community is structured as a limited-equity condominium association; the Near NorthWest Arts Council is the nonprofit developer and a resident

member. Training and technical assistance provided by the Chicago Mutual Housing Network, also a residential member.

Acme Artists Community, which reached full capacity for its 25 affordable living-and-workspace condos, is being hailed as a model for affordable artist communities.

ArtSpace-Cleveland's mission is to revitalize the community by connecting artists with studio spaces to live, work and create in the City of Cleveland. In 2011 ArtSpace-Cleveland expanded its mission to include an artist ownership initiative modeled after the Acme Artist Community in Chicago.
